



# Nationally Accredited Accuracy Checking for Pharmacy Technicians

## A Blended Learning Programme

### Assessment

There are three elements to the final assessment which are undertaken at a central location:

- Element 1 - Simulated Dispensing Accuracy Checking of dispensed items
- Element 2 – Portfolio Review
- Element 3 – Discussion of Practice Activities

#### Simulated Dispensing Accuracy Checking of Dispensed Items

The simulated checking of dispensed items against test prescription/medication orders is intended to test the professional skills and application of knowledge

#### Portfolio Review and Discussion of Practice Activities

The assessment panel will review the candidate's portfolio against specified criteria. The discussion is designed to assess the candidate's ability to accept responsibility as an ACPT. The panel will ask questions on the practice activities and all aspects of the accreditation process.

### Purpose of the 'Portfolio'

The portfolio forms part of the assessment. All evidence collected must be included in the portfolio for review and discussion during the Assessment Day. Evidence must be collected between Study Day and the Assessment Day.
