Practice Activities

Candidates must undertake a range of activities and record their experience in a Portfolio. The purpose of the portfolio is to:

- Document the checking that has been undertaken
- Ensure that a breadth of experience has been covered
- Highlight areas where further training is required

The portfolio forms part of the assessment. Evidence must be collected between the study days.

Practice activities include:

- Copies of SOP's relevant to your place of work
 - A diary log of 1000 checked items signed off by the Educational Supervisor
 - Reports of checking errors made by candidate
 - Appraisal of the candidate by the Educational Supervisor, to include summary of progress
 - Range of experience – speciality and prescription types
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
