Assessment

The competency-based summative assessment will assess performance and includes:

- **Case Study Presentation** - All candidates will be required to give a *10 minute presentation* of one case study involving a patient consultation episode. The presentation will take place on Study Day 2, and will be marked by a small panel.
- **Reflective Essay** - All candidates will be required to write a 1000 word reflective essay entitled “How their Patient Consultation skills have improved Patient centred care”
- **Portfolio Review** – Your e-portfolio will have gone through final review prior to the assessment day. The panel must be satisfied that the e-portfolio meets all the pre-set criteria.
- **External Review** - Candidates will be required to participate in an external review. The Pharmacy Technician Programmes Team will conduct the review. This will focus on the candidate’s experiences during training and understanding of Patient Consultations.

Purpose of the ‘Portfolio’

The portfolio forms part of the assessment. All evidence collected must be included in the portfolio for review and discussion during the assessment on Study Day 2. Evidence must be collected between Study Day 1 and Study Day 2.
